### Note

NOTE: Always pretest the product to determine the suitability and performance on your substrate for your specific purpose.

Installation Notice: Do not use any other adhesive products on these films. After installation, there may appear to be a haze on the window. The condition is temporary and is caused by moisture. It will disappear after the film dries, which could take up to 30 days.

The window film may be cleaned 30 days after installation using a gentle washing solution and soft cloth or synthetic sponge. The use of abrasive cleaning agents or stiff bristle brushes will scratch the surface and are not recommended.
